THE RESTORING JESUS

THE DISCLOSURE OF THE END OF THE AGE IS THE 'REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST' (REVELATION 1:1)

REALIZING NONE OF US COULD BRING THE PROMISED SEED (GENESIS 3:15) TO PASS, HUMANITY BEGAN TO CRY OUT FOR A DELIVERER. (GENESIS 4:26)

I. THE DELIVER COMES, THE END OF ALL MAN'S VIOLENCE

- A. Under the leadership of King Jesus, violence will end and we will begin to restore the earth. (Isaiah 2:2-4; Micah 4:4-5, Psalm 46:4-9, Psalm 72)
 - 1) The rewards and assignments we'll have in eternity are related to our stewardship and diligence in this age
 - 2) We'll see the fullness of God's restoration and redemption (Genesis 50:20, Romans 8:28) in eternity - and get to be part of it

II. CRUSHING THE SERPENT AND KILLING THE HARLOT

- A. Part of restoring means that He must end all sources of iniquity. (Genesis 3:15)
 - 1) Jesus returns (resurrection and rapture); we have the wedding supper of the Lamb; there are one thousand years of restoration; Satan is released for a time to sift the nations (Revelation 20); and then he's cast into the lake of fire FOREVER along with the harlot Babylon.
 - 2) The serpent and the harlot Babylon will receive permanent justice (Revelation 18:4-10, 19-24; Revelation 19:1-5)
- B. When Jesus returns, all kingdoms of the world will become His. (Revelation 11:15-18)
- C. Under Jesus' total reign, there will be total peace and justice (Psalm 72:17, Isaiah 9:6-7)

III. THE RESURRECTION

A. Because of the resurrection, we don't grieve as those without hope. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-14)

B. If you had to suffer the indignity of death and burial, you get raised first. If you had to watch your loved one go into their grave, you get to see them rise out of it and then get resurrected yourself. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)
