SESSION 19 THE METTLE FORGED IN SECRET

"Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. 2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. 3 For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. 4 But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor. 5 For each will have to bear his own load." (Galatians 6:1-5)

I. THE HAZARDS OF THIS AGE

- A. Sin that so easily ensnares us (Hebrews 12:1-4)
- B. There is something within us that desires victory and control
- C. The most rebellious thing we can do is to rebel against sin
 - 1. To resist the sin that so easily ensnares (Hebrews 12:4)
 - 2. Sin is like a flesh-eating cancer and must be immediately cut out
- D. To listen and not obey is to be like a man in the mirror who forgets what he looks like as soon as he walks away (James 1:23-24)
 - 1. When we do the opposite of this, there is blessing
 - 2. How do we keep ourselves spotless?

II. SEEK FIRST THE KINGDOM

- A. The mettle forged in secret is the crucifixion of self
- B. Seek first His kingdom (Matthew 6:33)
 - 1. He desires to provide for you, to care for you
- C. The Parable of the Sower (Matthew 13:3-9, 18-23)
- D. Hear, receive, grow roots, and produce fruit
- E. If you love the world, you don't love the Father (1 John 2: 15)
- F. The Antichrist is coming, there are already wolves in sheep's clothing (v. 18)
- G. We must fight against sin because it is what naturally feels most comfortable to us
- H. God's grace is sufficient for us (2 Corinthians 12:7-10)



III. THE ANTIDOTE

- A. There are three practical ways that we can war against the beast within, all of which are to be done in secret, only between you and the Father (Matthew 6)
 - 1. Giving (v. 1-4)
 - 2. Prayer (v. 5-13)
 - a) Adoration (v. 9)
 - b) Maranatha (v. 10)
 - c) Dependence (v. 11)
 - d) Forgiveness (v. 12)
 - e) Submission and awareness (v. 13)
 - 3. Fasting (v. 16-18)
- B. Hagar met the God who sees in secret (Genesis 16)
- C. If you can obey in the small moments, it's easier to fight in the big moments
 - 1. Daniel 11
 - 2. Ephesians 2:10
- D. God is eager to give you grace to be obedient
- E. Do difficult things with love in your heart, even in the secret places
