I. DELIVERANCE FROM OUR ENEMIES

- A. We have a clear picture of what it will look like when the Lord returns and the justice that He will bring (Micah 4:1-10)
- B. If all you do is love those who love you, there is no reward for that (Matthew 5:43-46)
- C. You're called to love your neighbor AND your enemy, the one who persecutes you1. This is the power of the Gospel in our lives
- D. We do not only seek deliverance from the danger of our enemies; our deliverance comes from our security in Christ as adopted children which allows us to love and pray for our enemies
- E. We are made whole in Jesus, nothing can pluck us from His hand
- F. The story of Saul and Ananias gives testimony to this (Acts 9)
- G. Persecute with love (Romans 12:14-21)
- H. The Lord will allow us to endure even the wrath of Satan in order to vindicate us (Revelation 3:7-13)
 - We are delivered from our enemies to love our enemies, and to endure even the worst that the devil can bring against us knowing that vindication belongs to the Lord
