I. THE UNITY OF HIS PEOPLE

- A. Jesus, through His kingship, pulls His people together and unites
 - 1. We will not find our unity in politics, doctrine, or our service
 - 2. Our unity is found in Jesus
- B. One of the most powerful components of Jesus' prayer is His prayer for unity, united together in Him ([John 17:21](#))
- C. To be sent by Jesus requires unity, not divisiveness
- D. He promises that Gentiles will be grafted in ([Romans 9, 10, 11](#))
- E. You are brought in ([Ephesians 2:13-18](#))
- F. Jesus makes a plan for both Jew and Gentile to brought to Him through the cross
- G. Ultimately, we will see more than just Jew and Gentile brought together in Jesus.
 - 1. We will see every tribe, every tongue, every nation ([Revelation 5:6, Revelation 7:9-10](#))
 - 2. There is no nation or people group who is left out of this worship
- H. This is what ultimate unity looks like- every tribe, tongue, and nation worshipping Jesus
