II. DURING THE TRIBULATION

- A. “They” means not only the Antichrist, but the nations who join him as well ([v. 31](#))
- B. Those who know God will stand firm and take action ([v. 32](#))
- C. “The wise” are those who have revelation, they will help others understand ([v. 33](#))
 - 1. We study these events so that we can be a blessing to others
 - 2. God calls us to give our lives and liberties away in order to overcome
- D. There is an appointed fullness of martyrdom, God won’t immediately step in ([v. 34](#))
- E. The Antichrist is a full manifestation of Satan, if you see him you see Satan
 - 1. This is why he is exalting himself above all others ([v. 36](#))
- F. Satan will take the highest place for 42 months
 - 1. Jesus will have the highest place forever because he went to the lowest place
- G. The world will, for the most part, stand by and watch these events unfold
- H. The Antichrist faces opposition from Egypt ([v. 40](#))
 - 1. There will be multiple campaigns, multiple battles
- I. Tens of thousands will fall, but “these will be delivered from his hands” ([v. 41](#))
 - 1. Refers to modern day Jordan and Saudi Arabia
- J. Upon seeing Egypt’s failure to overcome the Antichrist, North Africa will join his forces ([v. 43](#))
- K. The Antichrist will set up headquarters in-between Tel Aviv and Jerusalem ([v. 45](#))
- L. The fall of Egypt is further outlined in [Isaiah 16](#) and [Isaiah 19](#)
